

The Seventh Hong Kong Web Symposium - “2001: a WEB odyssey”

Details

To keep teachers abreast of the latest usage of IT in education and equip them with up-to-date knowledge of using IT in teaching and learning, schools are invited to nominate teachers to participate in the Seventh Hong Kong Web Symposium – “2001: A Web Odyssey” which will be organised by the Hong Kong Web Symposium Consortium on 2 and 3 May 2001 at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre. 2. Heads of schools are requested to nominate **at most 2 teachers** to attend the symposium. Completed Nomination Forms should be forwarded to the Information Technology Education Resource Centre by fax (2382 4403) on or before 18 April 2001. Nominations will be processed on a first-come-first-served basis and consideration will also be given to allow for more schools to participate.

3. Please note that the symposium is sponsored by the Quality Education Fund. To ensure **proper use and no wastage of public money, teachers accepted should attend the symposium on time**. If he/she is unable to attend the symposium before its commencement, head of the school should arrange another teacher to substitute and fill in a Substitution Note in order to prevent wastage of public money due to absenteeism. Head of school is required to fill in a Notice of Absence for every absentee to provide the reason(s) for absence and failing to make substitution on time. Completed Substitution Notes and Notices of Absence should be faxed to the Hong Kong Web Symposium Consortium (2547 4442) for necessary action.

4. Teachers **accepted** for the symposium will be notified by the Hong Kong Web Symposium Consortium through their school heads. Teachers attending the symposium are advised to use public transport. No parking spaces are available at the venue.

5. In the event of public announcement by the Director of Education that all schools are to be closed as a result of adverse weather conditions (e.g. tropical cyclone or rainstorm), symposium on that day will be cancelled.
